More routes throughout Ontario

The [Canadian Institute of Plumbing & Heating](#) and the [Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Institute of Canada](#) have announced that the second annual “**Ride for Habitat**” will take place on Saturday, August 20th. This new date allows Riders to return home from the end-point without having to contend with summer-cottage weekend traffic.

Co-sponsored by CIPH and HRAI, the motorcycle ride will raise funds for Habitat for Humanity Canada.

The Ride is rapidly growing in popularity. From one location/route in 2010, there will be at least four in 2011:

- Kingston/Belleville/Peterborough
- Vaughan
- Hamilton
- Waterloo

All routes will lead to Barrie, where lunch will be provided, courtesy of the HRAI Huronia Chapter and members of the Habitat Barrie affiliate. An additional route is being considered in Alberta. The committee has set a goal of 100 riders and \$10,000 raised for the charity.

Registration is \$50 per person, (for riders and passengers) and will be available starting June 15th through CIPH and HRAI.
